### Reality TV Show In Development for WA Pot Players

T ooks like reality TV is eyeballing Washington's legal marijuana licensees.

LA freelance researcher named Cheyenne Geysen-Chartrand has been reaching out to I-502 stakeholders on behalf of Vancouver BC-based Partners in Motion, a 20-year-old internationally known Media Company with projects that have aired on History Television, National Geographic, CBS, CTV, Discovery Channel, TLC and other notable networks.

Ms. Geysen-Chartrand states that, "We are currently in the development stages of creating a new and exciting unscripted television show called *Breaking Legal*. The plan for this series is to follow the lives of a few of the elite marijuana growers in America—the ones who have both the experience and the artistry to produce the biggest, most potent buds in the world—who are now being swept up into the latest legal entrepreneurial vortex, the retail production and sale of pot."

According to Ms. Geysen-Chartrand, the show's initial "unscripted" direction will follow the "transition from growing in secret, under fear of legal repercussions from seizure to fines to serious prison sentences, to being able to openly produce their product by following an entirely new set of laws."

Partners in Motion says the interest from broadcasters that would carry the show is firmly cemented. Current priorities for the show are to search for the "perfect cast" among Washington's current I-502 licensees. "At this early stage, purely assessing interest, feasibility and answering any questions potential cast members may have is our top priority," Geysen-Chartrand said. "Above anything else, we know that it will take the right people, the right personalities, and the right relationships to get a show like this off the ground, and on the air," she continued.

### **Super Tech For Retailers & Dispensaries**

In this issue we talk a lot about security. It's an important staple for any marijuana business and impacts licensing, safety and profitability. put into bringing their operation up to code.

Unlicensed facilities create a serious public safety hazard and enjoy an unfair competitive advantage over those who are doing it right. Interestingly, and likely a legacy of the semi-street nature of those good of gray days before MMJ purveyors in Oregon knew where they stood legally, most HB3460 owners refuse to "drop a dime" on the outlaws. I would encourage everybody to snitch away. You can report and complain about noncompliant dispensaries by contacting the Medical Marijuana Dispensary Program at (855) 244-4074 or medmj.dispensaries@state. or.us. Alternatively, and at a minimum, please INSIST on seeing a dispensary's HB3460 Registration Certificate to verify that it's a licensed HB3460 operation. Displaying the Registration Certificate is mandatory and also one of the common "minor issues" the recent inspections turned up.

One in 12 inspection fails is more ominous than it sounds. It's an 8.3% revocation rate and means another 11ish HB3460 operators could lose their license because they fell out of compliance with HB3460 rules—based on the 138 dispensaries licensed in Oregon as of June 23rd, 2014. HB3460 license revocations would climb to a total of 25 closed dispensaries when applying the fail rate to all 307 pending dispensary applications.

The inspection process is fairly routine and the Oregon Health Authority's Medical Marijuana Dispensary Program compliance officers are positive and helpful. About seven days after your inspection you'll receive a letter from the OHA-MMDP and an Inspection Findings Report, which is where inspectors detail the two types of issues they note: Recommendations and Deficiencies.

The OHA-MMDP letter explains that "Recommendations are items that were found to be in compliance with the rules but which could be improved. You're not required to respond to any item marked as a recommendation but it is advised that the PRF review the items and take

### It's HB3460 Inspection Time!

Compliance staff began the mandatory inspections in late May, but as of this writing only 12 dispensaries have gone through the inspection process.

The casual pace at which state officials appear to be grinding through the inspections should give Oregon's new medical marijuana dispensary operators a chance to double check some of the regulatory requirements that need to be in place in order for their dispensary to continue to operate.

I suggest that you review your dispensary's compliance status sooner rather than later. These inspections have teeth. If it feels like the task is beyond your ken, there are several "Green-Rush" consultants and attorneys in Oregon that can quickly review, identify and fix marijuana business compliance issues.

Since the inspections started, the state has sent four letters to facilities telling them they must close. However, OHA-Medical Marijuana Dispensary Program spokeswoman Karyn Fish stated that only one closure was the result of a failed inspection. Two were facilities whose applications were denied but they continued to operate and the other was for a location that had never attempted to register.

By the way, Ms. Fish also states that "The program also investigates complaints of unlicensed or noncompliant facilities." I know a lot of properly licensed HB3460 dispensary owners fuming about

the scofflaws flagrantly operating unlicensed, noncompliant dispensaries throughout the state. It's grossly unfair that HB3460 licensees have poured often tens, or even hundreds of thousands of dollars into creating beautiful, safe, 100% compliant wellness centers while the rule breakers steal customers and pocket the money that should be

any steps necessary to improve the safety and operation of the dispensary."

The problems that the inspectors define as "Deficiencies" are more urgent. The OHA-MMDP letter explains that "Deficiencies require corrective action as follows: the PRF must submit a signed Plan of Correction within 10 business days from the date of this letter; the PRF must correct all deficiencies within 10 days from the date of this letter, unless an extension is requested from the Authority. A request for such an extension shall be submitted in writing and must accompany the Plan of Correction. Send supporting documentation as evidence of compliance with the rules. If there is no written response within the designated time frame, or the response is inadequate, the dispensary may be subject to civil penalties of up to \$500 per day per violation."

It takes a keen eye and an intimate understanding of the Oregon Administrative Rules to thoroughly review a dispensary for compliance issues. Also note, the penalty fees associated with the following case study would amount to \$10,000 a day if the PRF failed to address the Deficiencies within the required 10 day window, or provided fixes the state judged ineffective. Ouch!

DIY or not, please take a moment to survey your operation and ensure that your six month and annual inspections don't hold any unwanted surprises. GOOD LUCK!



### Washington's J-Day!

Tuesday, July 8th, I-502 retailers in several Washington cities will open their doors for the state's first day of retail marijuana sales under its voter approved Initiative 502 program.

As we wrote about last month (*I*-502 Crop Flop June, 2014), retail stores will have a challenging time filling shelves because of the limited number of growers the Washington State Liquor Control Board (WSLCB) has approved and the limited amount of time those growers have had to grow the marijuana that will stock the I-502 retail system.

The WSLCB's glacial pace of rolling out producer and processor licenses may indicate that investigators are doing a rigorous job at vetting the best candidates for licensure, however, it has also created a chokepoint in the supply chain that will likely drive up prices to black market friendly levels and make the consistent acquisition of specific strains of marijuana an extremely challenging task for retailers.

As of July 1, 2014 the WSLCB has issued a total of 63 licenses to I-502 producers. But it's the rate at which The Board has approved those licenses that has kinked up marijuana production levels. If those 63 producers had been growing since early March, when Spokane's Kouchlock Productions was awarded the state's first grow license, there would be a significantly greater amount of Class A usable marijuana available to retailers for Washington's launch of retail marijuana sales.

Unfortunately, only a fraction of the currently approved licensees have had enough time to produce significant quantities of marijuana. Kouchlock was awarded their license on March 5th, 2014. More than a month later, the WSLCB had only issued an additional 9 licenses. And sixty days after Mr. Green at Kouchlock got his license, the state had approved only 29 growers.

More than 80% of Washington's approved pot producers have had less than 90 days to grow marijuana since getting their license—and a whopping 50% have had less than 60 days to raise a crop. Even assuming a hyper-optimistic growth cycle projection of 60 days indicates that Washington's entire marijuana supply for the retailers opening on July 8th is coming from just 29 growers.

The scarcity of suppliers combined with the anticipated consumer crush on July 8th likely means Washington's retail pot prices will skyrocket. Most of the retailers I have spoken to are being quoted between \$3,000 and \$4,000 per pound. But it's likely that will go up as we approach J-Day.

So, what can you do to ensure your I-502 retail store has hooch on July 8th?

Think Long Term. Try to find processors with which you can create long-term relationships. If you work together with producer/processors you can influence the strains they grow, how the marijuana is packaged for your store and create other efficiencies that are mutually beneficial to both you and your supplier. You can help your supplier by finding other retailers that may join you in purchasing a particular strain from a producer/processor.

Think Short Term. The next few months are likely to be extremely stressful for most retailers. Strain volatility, the inevitable breakdown of equipment typical with any new venture and less profitability than perhaps most retailers anticipated. For the next year or so producer/processors are definitely in the driver's seat when it comes to strain availability and pricing. Until the WSLCB tweaks the rules as they relate to production limits (and increases the absurd 2,000,000 ft.² canopy limit) prices are likely to be higher than anyone anticipated. However, consumers are probably braced for higher prices, at least initially, after watching the price of marijuana balloon to over \$500 an ounce during Colorado's Amendment 64 week-one launch.

**Lock It Down.** Once you've found a producer/processor you like working with, consider having them sign a production contract. It can be an incentive for the producer/processor because it can guarantee income for their marijuana growing and processing operation. And it's good for you because, you know, you need weed in your store.

Go with a Pro. Increase your supply chain options by using professional marijuana strain acquisition services. Use a professional marijuana strain acquisition agent who can secure preferred pricing and stabilized access to the strain-specific inventory your customers require. These specialized marijuana sales facilitators help retailers lockdown supply-chain relationships that prevent inventory volatility, enhance customer loyalty and increase profitability—all within I-502 rules.

**Pay the Freight.** I suggest doing everything in your power to get those jars filled soon, including overpaying. There'll be no shortage of customers for Washington I-502 retailers. The same cannot be said for the marijuana those customers seek.
